**Adoption Statement - Notice of adoption of the Flood Risk Sequential and
Exception Test Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)**

On 23 November 2021 East Riding of Yorkshire Council adopted the Flood Risk Sequential and Exception Test Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). The adopted SPD provides further guidance on the application of Policy ENV6 (Managing Environmental Hazards) of the East Riding Local Plan Strategy Document and will be an important material consideration in the determination of planning applications.
